EFCA new mandate

Inter-Agencies cooperation



- Similar article amending founding Regulations of EFCA, EMSA and FRONTEX
- Objective: to give the 3 EU Agencies a key role for establishing a European cooperation on Coast Guard Functions (CGF)
- On-going developments (2016-2017 Pilot Project) in the area of training/capacity building:
 - Develop outline of Guidelines on inter-EU agencies cooperation;
 - Assess the feasibility and eventually design a concept for voluntary staff exchange;
 - Common list of possible/available training courses related to CGF and of mutual interest for the 3 Agencies and their stakeholders (cf. for example 2017 EFCA training catalogue of courses).



EFCA multiannual work programme 2017-2021



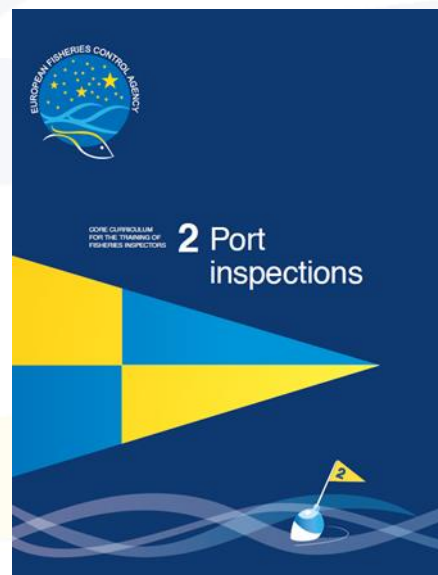
Training activities and material based on the Core Curricula:

- Training the trainers/Union inspectors
- E-learning tutorials
- Core Curricula updating/promotion in Member States
- Capacity building in third countries

Coast Guard/EU Agencies cooperation on capacity building:

- Joint training courses with other EU Agencies
- Contribution to handbook/guidelines on EU collaboration (CGF context, cf. new Art. 7a(3) of EFCA founding Regulation)

- Harmonised methodology for training of inspectors
- New e-learning courses + translations
- Support to Member States activities on request
- Finalisation Pilot Project on EU CGF cooperation (task 3: outline of guidelines) on capacity building
- Contribution to a common SQF for MS CGF authorities





Possible cooperation areas/synergies with ECGFA II NET Project



- EFCA participation to the network as observer
- Training portal: EFCA training calendar/catalogue + possibly e-learning
- CGF Sectoral Qualification Framework: EFCA support for technical review on fisheries control and inspection elements
